

# **“AUTOMOBILE ROLLOVER CONTEST RULES - 2022”**

**COVID REQUIREMENTS, please follow all State/CDC guidelines.**

- 1) Figure 8 rules #3 on website will apply, except rules 10b, 16a and 16b.
- 2) 4-point racing harness seat belt is recommended.
- 3) Heavy screen/wire mesh must be secured over the driver's door window.
- 4) Each car must have a rollover bar. A full roll cage is recommended. Example: 3"- 4" square stock or heavy wall pipe extending from the floor to the roof with a 6"- 8" plate welded on each end, bolted in 4 positions through the roof and 4 positions through the floor. **ALL ROLL CAGES MUST BE INSIDE THE VEHICLE.**
- 5) Foam padding must be used on all areas around the driver to prevent your helmet and body from hitting any metal surface, see 16d on figure 8 rules.
- 6) Tire air pressure may be increased, see rating on tire. If you get a flat tire on the driver's side, it must be changed before your next attempt. Bring extra tires.
- 7) Welding and extra metal will be permitted to strengthen the suspension.
- 8) Battery will be permitted inside the driver's compartment or trunk, providing it is totally secured with several straps (no rubber bungees) and completely covered.
